Integrating PowerNotes into Your Workflow

- 1. **Install the Chrome Extension**: PowerNotes Help & Support
- 2. Create a New Project: Organize your research by project.
- 3. **Add and Annotate Sources**: Highlight key insights and note the role of each source in your white paper.
- 4. **Export Annotations**: After annotating at least five sources, export your project's data as a spreadsheet.
- 5. **Submission**: Upload the resulting spreadsheet to Canvas for review.

Zotero: Efficient Reference Management

- ► Free, open-source reference management tool
- ► Collect references from databases and websites
- Organize materials with collections and tags
- Generate citations and bibliographies in various styles
- ► Integration with word processors

Incorporating Zotero into Your Research Process

- 1. **Install Zotero and Browser Connector**: Download from Zotero's official website.
- Collect References: Use the browser connector to save references and PDFs.
- Organize Your Library: Create collections and use tags for efficient management.
- 4. **Cite as You Write**: Utilize Zotero's word processor integration to insert citations.
- 5. **Generate Bibliographies**: Automatically create and format bibliographies.
